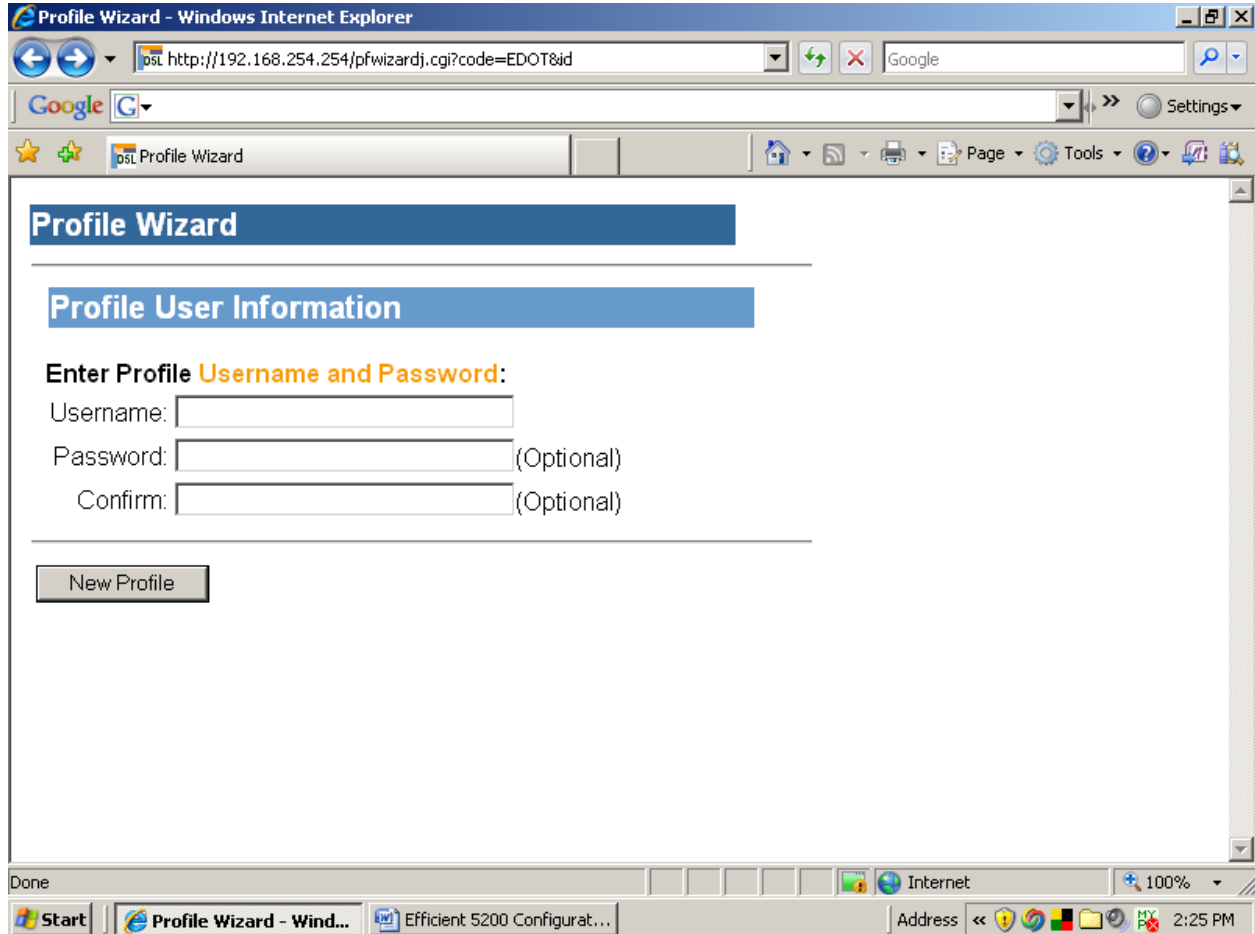


## Efficient 5200 Set-up Instructions

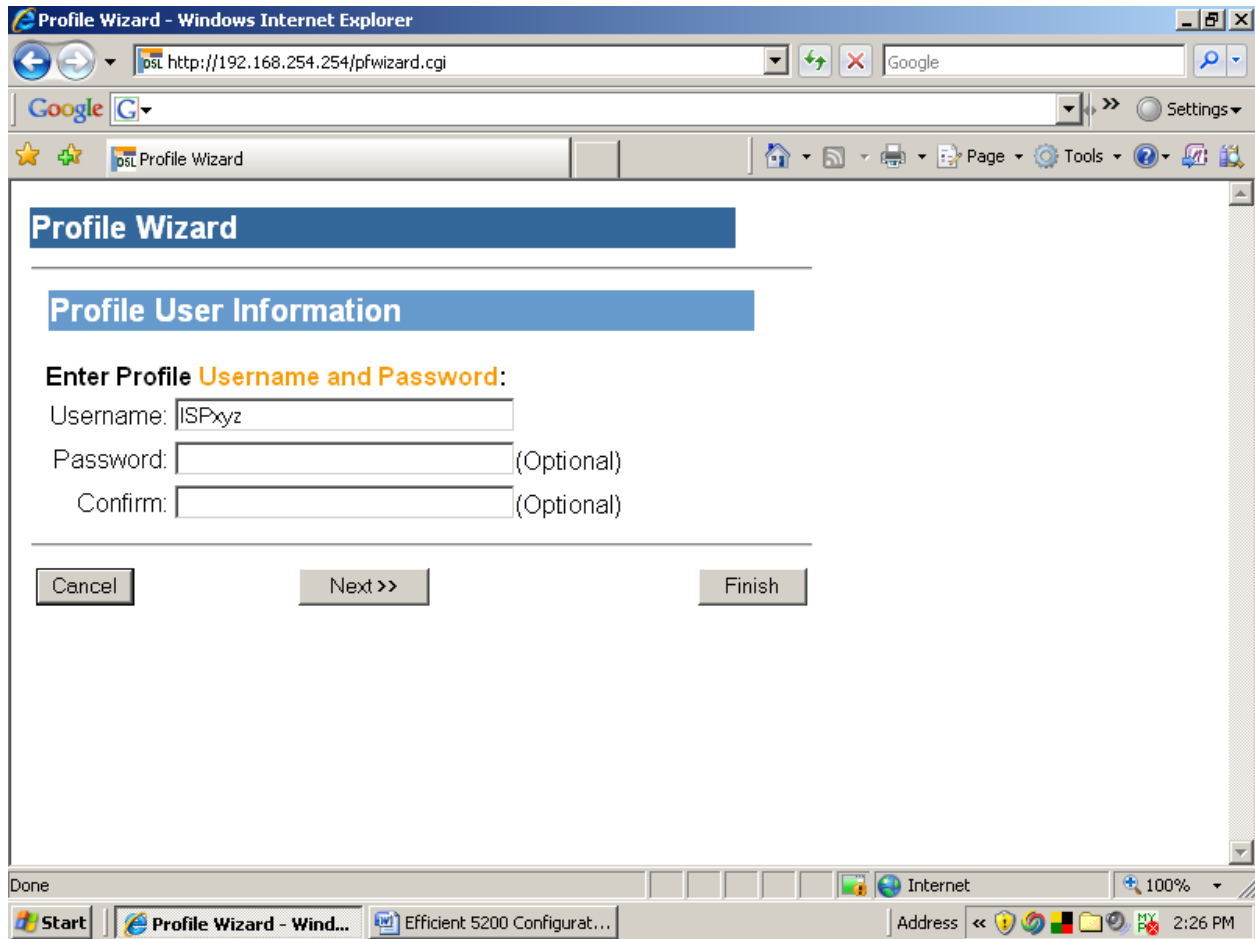
1) Use Profile editor to log into the modem.

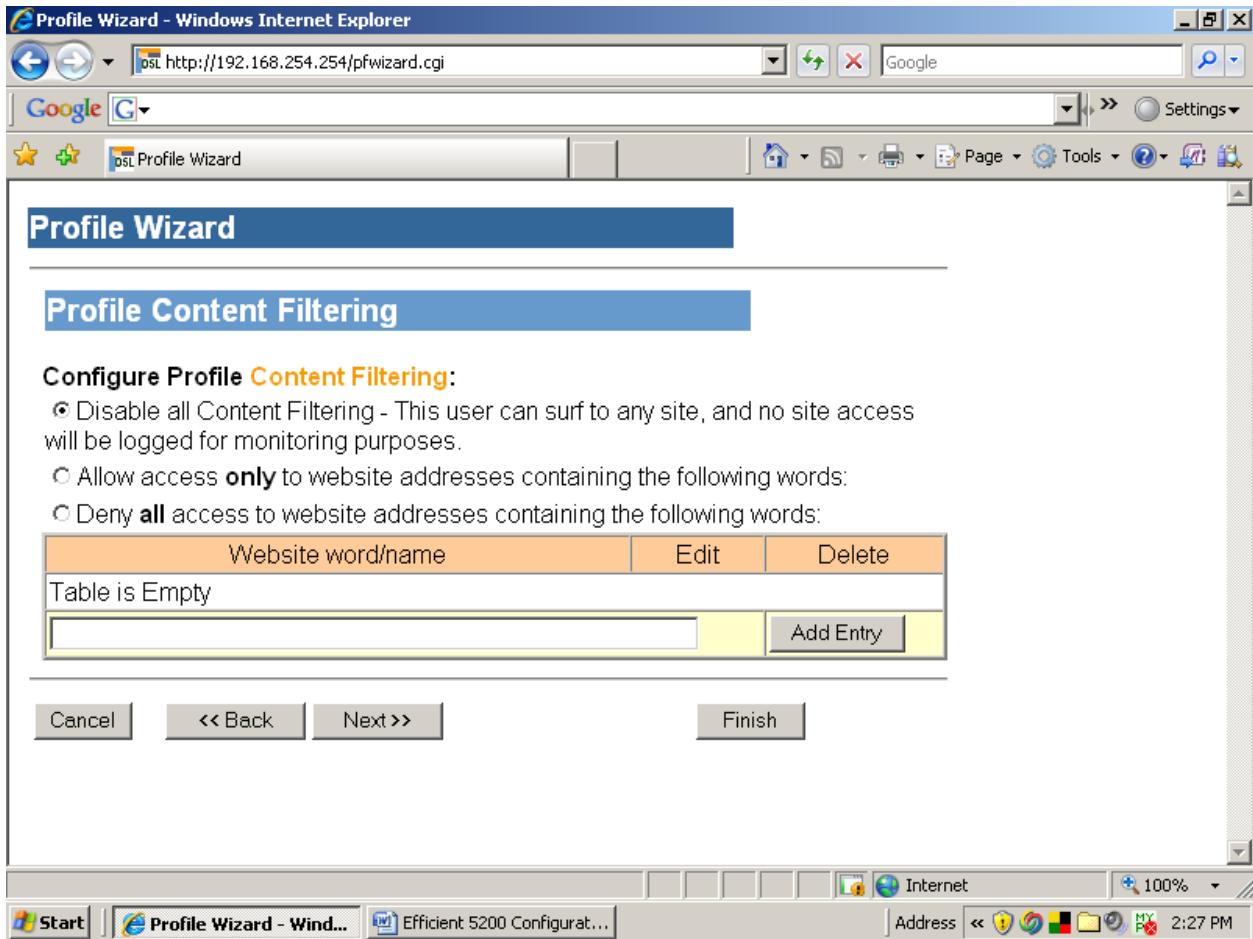
Don't enter any info. Click on "New Profile". The same screen comes back up.



2) Enter a username (e.g ISPxyz). Password is not necessary.



3) Click "Next". Select the type of content filtering you want. Default is "Disable all content....." Then Click 'Next'



4) Profile Configuration Access. By default there is nothing checked. Click on "ALL Items". Now all boxes are checked and all capabilities of the modem are available. Click "Next" (Image Below)

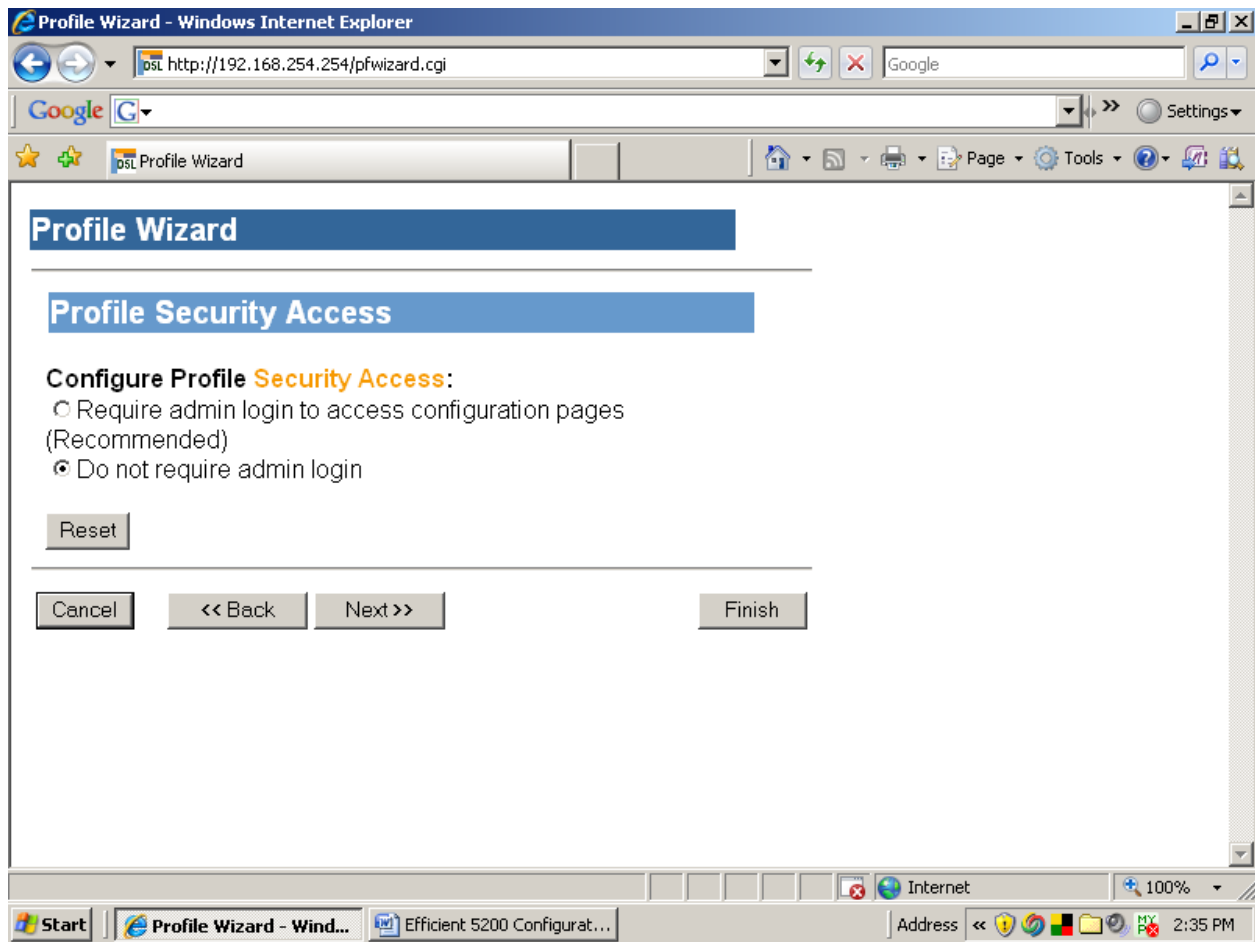

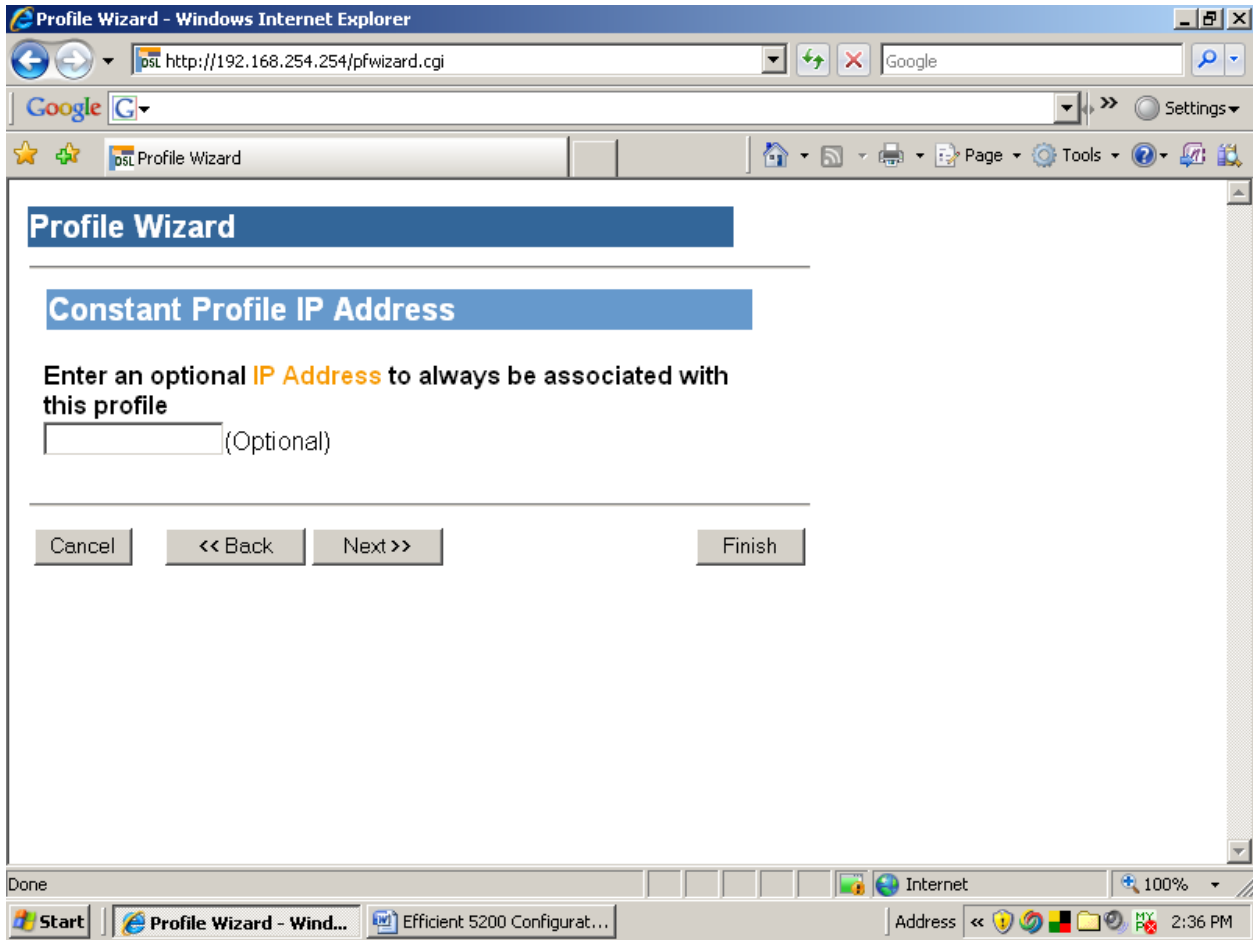

## 5) Profile Security Access

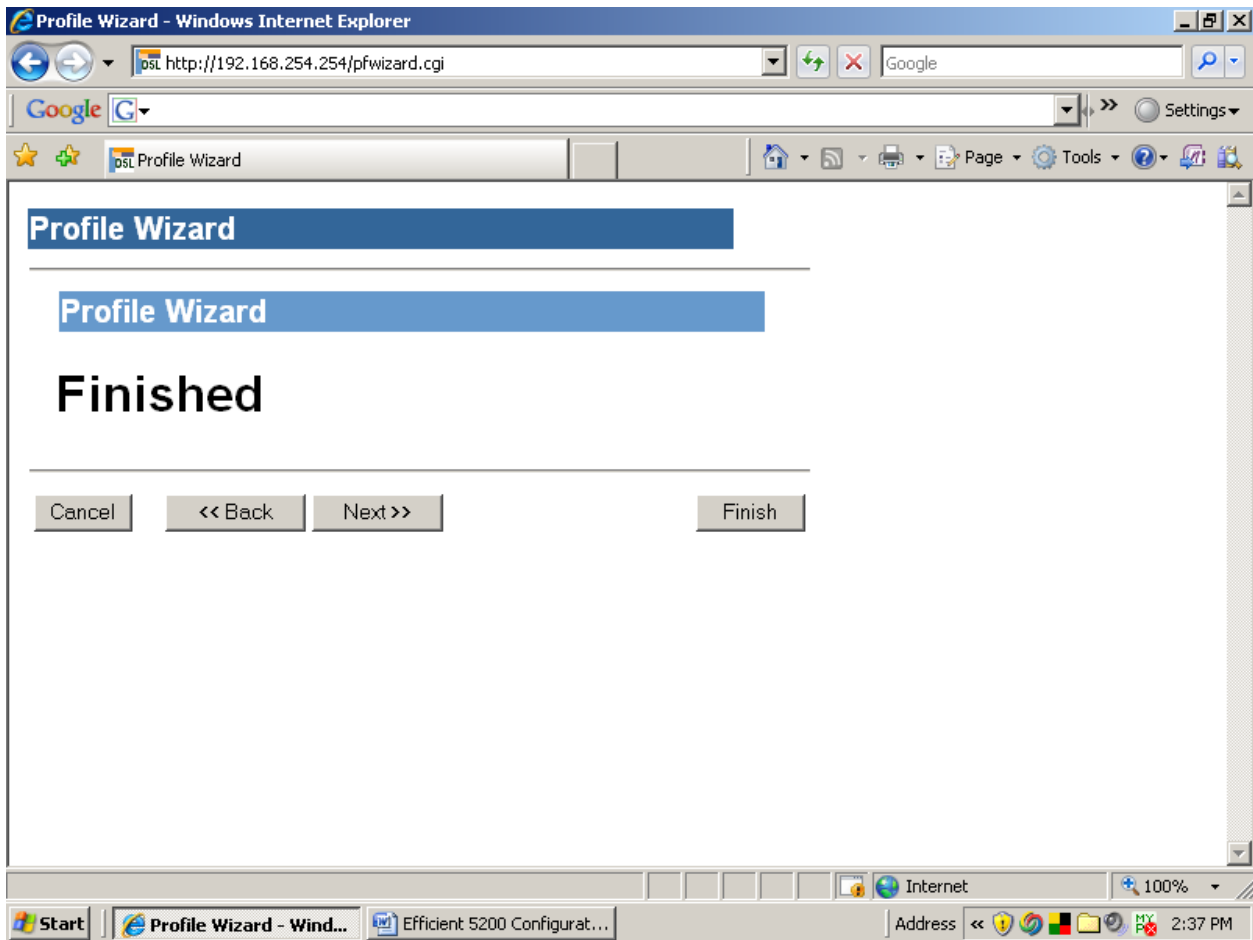
By default it is set to: "Require admin login...". We use "Don't require admin login". Click "Next"




6) Constant IP profile (We leave it blank) Click "Next"

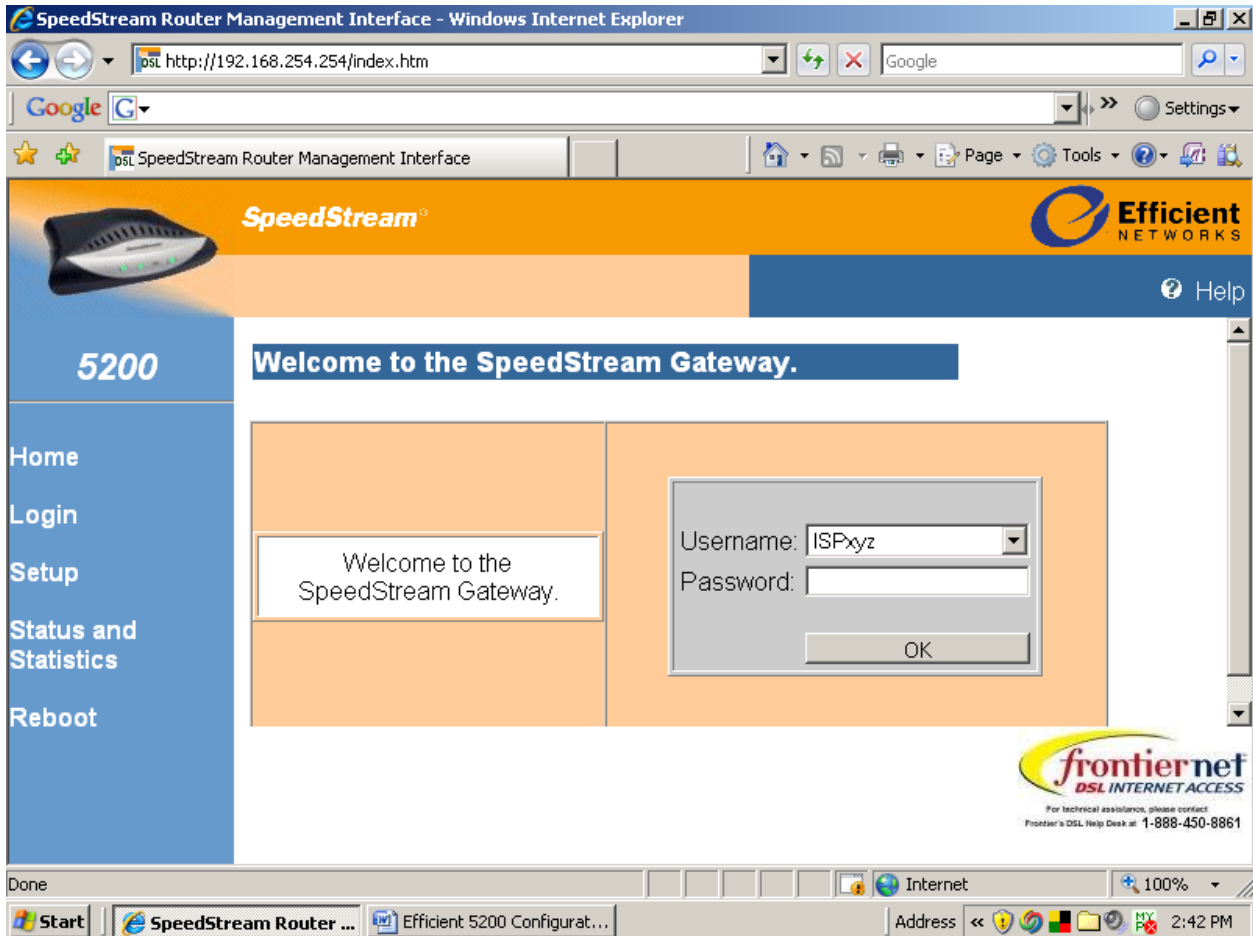

9) Log back into the modem at 192.168.254.254. When the screen appears you may have to hit "Logout". Go ahead and logout and then click on the login button. From the pull down tab, locate the Username that was put in the modem via Profile Editor. (For this example ISPxyz) and hit OK.

After you have logged in, click on setup on the left hand side of the screen.



10) Click on WAN interface

11) Click on the numbers below VC (this example click on the 0/35)

12) Change the VC to your specifications. Scroll down and hit next and continue to set the modem up to your needs. Bridge, PPPOE, PPPOA etc...

Once you get to the end of set-up, scroll down to the bottom of the page and click on "reboot". This will reboot the modem and save your settings!
